


Team Member Qualities

Show Responsibility

- If you are unable to attend a meeting, let a team mentor know at least 2 days in advance
- If you commit to getting work done, you have the responsibility to have it done by then.




Demonstrate Accountability

- Own up to mistakes during and outside FIRST competitions
- Make it clear when you do not understand something or need help
- It is your job to complete work when it is due/assigned
- Show honesty!



Show Diligence and Good Work Ethic

- A good work ethic goes a long way in FIRST and it is a great characteristic to have as so get older
- This quality helps the team get the work done on time
- Always complete what you started even when that means staying after hours to get the job done
- When the work is done diligently there are usually little or no mistakes which allows for extra time to be spent on areas of the team that need more attention




Demonstrate Good Teamwork Skills

- Work well with others in even in times of pressure
- Be open to all ideas, and be willing to compromise, even if some of the ideas are not your own
- Do not be afraid to ask for help or say you don't know. If not, it will only hurt the team
- Always be willing to help others out when in need of assistance, even if you have to stop what you are doing



Stay Focused At All Times

- Stay off of your cell phone during practice
- Be willing to give mentors and students your utmost focus at every meeting or event
- Do not get distracted by playing with the team equipment or horse playing (it can be a safety issue)
